## APPROX TIMINGS FOR THE DAY

**10AM-10:30AM**

STAGGERED ARRIVAL TIMES FOR DANCE SCHOOLS, DANCERS AND CHAPERONES. WILL BE REGISTERED BY A MEMBER OF THE HEAT TEAM AND ESCORTED THROUGH TO DRESSING ROOMS.

**10:45AM**

WELCOME AND SAFETY TALKS IN THE MAIN AUDITORIUM.

**11AM**

FINALE RUN-THROUGH ON STAGE WITH THE WHOLE CAST.

REHERSALS BEGIN. EACH DANCE SCHOOL WILL HAVE A 20-MINUTE SLOT TO REHERSE THEIR FIRST PERFORMANCE FROM ACT ONE. THIS WILL RUN IN LINE WITH THE RUNNING ORDER OF THE SHOW. REHERSALS WILL BE IN FULL COSTUME ON THE STAGE.

REHERSALS CONTINUE FOR ACT 2. EACH DANCE SCHOOL WILL HAVE A 15-MINUTE SLOT TO REHERSE THEIR SECOND PERFORMANCE FROM ACT 2. THIS WILL RUN IN LINE WITH THE RUNNING ORDER OF THE SHOW. REHERSALS WILL BE IN FULL COSTUME ON THE STAGE.

RETURN TO DRESSING ROOMS TO GET READY FOR SPECTATORS.

**3:30PM**

SHOW TIME! THERE WILL BE A 20-MINUTE INTERVAL BETWEEN ACT ONE AND ACT TWO.

**6:00PM**

APPROX FINISH TIME

**6:30PM**

DANCERS ARE TO LEAVE THE THEATRE VIA THE DESIGNATED EXIT POINT. DANCERS SHOULD LEAVE WITH CHAPERONES AND BE COLLECTED BY PARENTS/GUARDIANS.

# TAKE PART

## **Minimum Numbers of Performers**

We require all dance schools to bring a minimum number of 10 performers to a HEAT theatre event. The maximum number of performers the stage can accommodate is approximately 45 performers at any one time.

## **Dance School Registration**

All dance schools taking part in HEAT events are required to register their dance school for the event through the Google Form provided.

## **Dancer Registration**

All performers must complete the online registration process through the additional Google Form provided. This should be completed 6 weeks before the event. A registration fee of £25 is payable by each performer and the fee includes a HEAT finale t-shirt, which will be provided to the performer on the show day.

## **Tickets**

All performers are required and responsible for selling a minimum of 2 tickets for a HEAT theatre show (they agree to this upon registration in the terms and conditions). Additional tickets are also available and there is no limit on the amount you can buy, but they will be sold on a first come first basis.

For any siblings taking part, 2 tickets must be purchased on behalf of the family.

# TAKE PART

## Deposit

A £100 deposit is required to secure your place in Heat Dance Competition and Events 'Bring the Heat'. This is refundable on successful completion of the event, which includes bringing the minimum number of performers AND meeting your minimum ticket requirements.

Please note- that payment of the deposit does not release the dance school's requirement to sell a minimum number of tickets. All dancers (or their parents who complete the registration form on their behalf) commit to selling a minimum of 2 tickets for the show. The general public do not come to watch these performances, it is only family, friends, and supporters of the performer taking part who should purchase tickets.

## Performance Time

The amount of performance time per dance school is based on the number of performers taking part in the show.

Please note- Dance Schools will have one slot in each act of the show (totaling 2 across the show). A slot can include multiple numbers however we will accept only one file of music per slot. We will not play two files back to back and we will not make more than one announcement for each performance.

NUMBER OF DANCERS TAKING PART	MAXIMUM TIME LIMIT ACROSS BOTH PERFORMANCES
10-19	10 MINUTES
20-29	15 MINUTES
30-39	20 MINUTES
40 +	22 MINUTES

It is up to the dance school how they split their performance time across the two performances in each act. For example, Act 1 Performance 1 could be 7 minutes and Performance 2 could be 8 minutes totalling your 15-minute allocated performance time.

You do not need to fill your maximum time limit, but there are no additional slots available if you do not fill your time limit. All the dancers also return to the stage for the finale at the end of the show.

Play-offs are allowed but should included in your time allowance.

Dancers can appear in one or all of your performances based on your preference.

We welcome all styles of dance and musical theatre. It is the variety of performance that we pride ourselves on and it keeps the shows interesting and exciting. Tap is welcomed, but please note the stage is not mic'd. Musical Theatre is also welcomed but please be aware the use of handheld microphones or head mics would be at an additional cost, as they would need to be hired. We would arrange for a quick sound check before dress rehearsal.

# TAKE PART

## Stage

Performance area=

Depth= 7.63m (25ft)

Total Width with wings= 20.9m (68ft)

3x wings for entrances/exits (1x downstage, 1x mid-stage, 1x upstage)

Dancers can move from one side of the stage to the other behind the stage.

## Finale

All dancers are invited back to the stage at the end of the show for the company finale. Dancers should wear HEAT t-shirts for the finale, which will be in their dressing room on arrival at the theatre on show day. It is up to yourself what the dancers wear with their finale t-shirt (eg. Black leggings/ part of their costume from the show etc), but shoes must be worn. The finale is the curtain call.

## Information for the programme

For your school to be included in the programme we require the information listed below to be sent to us as soon as possible.

- Troupe Photograph (2 images per dance school)
- Biography (information about your school and troupe)
- Dance School Logo
- Cast List confirmation
- Performance titles and dance order preference

## Licensing and Chaperones

HEAT will apply to local councils for the necessary performance licenses required for your dancers to take part in the event. The information we require for the dancers will be collected during the registration stage, therefore all dancers must register.

We will need some details of your chaperones (Name, Address, contact number, DBS number, and chaperone license). The recommended ratio are 1 chaperone per 8 children. Chaperones must stay backstage with dancers at all times and cannot watch the show from the auditorium, but can watch from the wings.
